Historically, women were focused on homemaking and supporting their husbands, with limited opportunities for education and careers, while societal norms reinforced stereotypes.





Advocacy for gender equality raises awareness in all aspects of life.



Women's roles have evolved from traditional duties to active participation across all sectors. As gender equality progresses, women break barriers and lead the way for empowerment, innovation, and leadership.






